Eastern Europe Pilgrimage with Fr. Dean

Three of us from St. Thomas Parish went on Fr. Dean's recent trip to Poland, Budapest (Hungary), Austria (Vienna) and the Prague (Czech Republic). Each day of the trip Fr. Dean and Fr. Michael Berndt celebrated mass, often in centuries-old churches, with our group of 43 people.

We toured Poland, the beautiful homeland of our own Fr. Pawel. We visited the site of the Second Black Madonna, known as the Queen of Poland. We went to Wadowice, the birthplace of St. Pope John Paul II. We had mass in the church across the street from the childhood home of the Pope. We visited and prayed at the Shrine of Divine Mercy where St. Faustina is entombed.

In stark and unforgettable contrast, we also toured the barracks and gas chamber at the Auschwitz Concentration Camp. There seem to be no words to explain how and why such a place could ever have existed.

From Poland we went on to Budapest, saw Hero's Square and had an evening cruise on the Danube, viewing the beauty of the city under lights.

Next we went to Vienna, Austria where we toured the beautiful city, as well as a palace. In the evening, we enjoyed a very special restaurant and had a wonderful dinner. Of course we did some shopping in each of these places, sampling the specialties in each locale.


Our final country was the Czech Republic where we visited the city of Prague. We had mass at the Church of Our Lady Victorious which contains the Infant of Prague statue. We did lots of walking, which was typical of each city we visited.

The three of us, Alice Addis, Theresa Volk, and Rita Kocher thoroughly enjoyed the trip. For each of us the trip was a learning experience. We realized that we knew very little about the history of this region. Each of these countries has enjoyed a time of rebuilding after WWII and then in the last 35 years, since their release from Communist rule.
