

- 8 a.m. 12:30 p.m.: Eucharistic procession (5 miles) through Springfield from the Cathedral to Blessed Sacrament Church for Benediction to Sacred Heart Convent of the Springfield Dominican Sisters for Benediction to St. Agnes Church for Benediction
- 5:30 7:30 p.m.: Evening Prayer, followed by a potluck dinner and witness talks at Sacred Heart Church in Effingham


